Frosh and varsity teams are assigned to races without regard to enrollment. \*Additional varsity race may be added if entries necessitate.

Varsity awards for each race:

- 1) Championship trophies- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams
- 2) Plaques to seven members of the winning team and seven medals to second and third place teams.
- 3) Trophies to top ten finishers.
- 4) Medals for places 11-50.

### Frosh awards for each race:

1) Trophies for top three finishers; medals for places 4-50. (No frosh team awards.)

Entry Fees: \$175.00 per varsity team (\$350.00 boys and girls)

\$30.00 per individual varsity entry

\$120.00 per frosh team of 7 runners; B entries allowed (\$240.00 boys and

girls)

\$25.00 per individual frosh entry

## Note:

- 1) Late fee of \$50.00 for entries received after October 14, 2019. Late entries only accepted through the athletic director, Craig Najarian: 617-469-8004.
- 2) Seven competitors only will be allowed to go to the starting line in varsity races. A team will be disqualified if more than seven runners go to the starting line.
- 3) Runners must wear numbers and school uniforms.
- 4) Be sure that your A.D. or principal signs the entry blank. No entry will be accepted without this signature.
- 5) A school is responsible for entry fees when it enters the meet whether that school competes or not.
- 6) In Frosh races "B" entries are allowed. (additional fee)
- 7) Boston Park Rangers will coordinate parking and will call buses for pick up.
- 8) Portable toilets are available for all runners, coaches, and spectators.

Coaches will pick up numbers and race assignments from the Meet Director (Vin Catano) on the day of the Meet.
