Information	Burlington is a 6-lane composite track with an 8-lane straightaway
High Jump	2 high jump pits will be used. Athletes may take no more than 6 total jumps in the competition. High jump will start as low as 1.23m (approximately 4') and will move in 5cm increments.
Long Jump	There will be one long jump pit with a painted board Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals. All fair attempts will be measured in metric.
Triple Jump	Burlington: There will be one triple jump pit with painted boards at 20', 24', 28', 32', 36' Bishop Feehan: There will be one triple jump pit with painted boards at 24', 28', 32', 36' Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals. All fair attempts will be measured in metric.
Shot Put	Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals. All fair attempts will be measured in metric. Athletes must bring their own 12 lb. shot puts Burlington HS will have a second shot put circle for warmups
Discus Throw	Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals. All fair attempts will be measured in metric. Athletes must bring their own 1.6 kilogram discus Burlington will have a second discus cage for warmups
Javelin Throw	Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals. All fair attempts will be measured in metric. Athletes must bring their own 800 gram javelins Javelin will use a grass runway at both sites
Equipment	Blocks will be provided, please do not bring your own
