Team/Athlete Participation	Each school may enter between 1 and 6 athletes. Three athletes score as a team (A and B teams allowed). Teams must be declared prior to the start of competition.

Spikes	Only 1/8" or 1/4" PYRAMID spikes allowed. Anyone using needle spikes or longer spikes than
	recommended will be immediately disqualified and banned for the remainder of the meet.
Facility Information	Notre Dame Academy is an 8-lane composite track with an 8-lane straightaway
	Weston is a 6-lane composite track with an 8-lane straightaway
High Jump	2 high jump pits will be used at Notre Dame and Weston
	Athletes may take no more than 6 total jumps in the competition.
	High jump will start as low as 1.03m (approximately 3'4.5") and will move in 5cm increments.
Long Jump	There will be two long jump pits with a painted board at both sites
	Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals.
	All fair attempts will be measured in metric.
Shot Put	Both sites will use one shot put area
	Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals.
	All fair attempts will be measured in metric.
	Athletes must bring their own 8 kg. shot puts that meet all NFHS specifications
Javelin Throw	Weston and Notre Dame may use two javelin areas
	Javelin will use a grass runway at Weston and 1 grass, 1 composite at Notre Dame
	Athletes will be given 3 attemptsno finals.
	All fair attempts will be measured in metric.
	Athletes must bring their own 600 gram javelins that meet all NFHS specifications
Equipment	Blocks will be provided, please do not bring your own
Order of Events	<ul> <li>Day one begins with the 100-meter hurdles for all athletes (random seeding)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Athletes will rotate either shot put/ high jump or javelin/ long jump on day one</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Day one ends with the 200-meter dash for all athletes (random seeding)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Athletes will rotate either shot put/ high jump or javelin/ long jump on day two</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Day two ends with the 800-meter run for all athletes (seeded by points)</li> </ul>
