	LATE ENTRIES: Late entries are strongly discouraged; however, there is a late fee policy for MSTCA meets. If you miss the Monday (4/7/19) deadline, and still want your team to compete, you must contact the meet director by Wednesday, 4/9, no later than 7 p.m. He is the only one to deal with this request. You will not be able to access Direct Athletics. The late fee will be \$100 per person or relay. No entries will be accepted after Wednesday 4/9 at 7:00 p.m. Schools that enter late entrants must bring to the meet a check or Purchase Order for the entry fees plus the late fees, to give to the meet director, or they will not be allowed to compete.
