Facility Information	The track is a 8-lane composite track.
High Jump	 There will be two composite high jump pits in use. Starting Height: Girls 3' 11.5", Boys 4' 7.75" Attempts will be measured in metric units. Height progression will be opening height, then up by 5 centimeters.
Long Jump	 There will be two long jump pits in use. Each athlete will receive 3 attempts. All fair attempts will be measured in metric units.

Shot Put	 There will be one shot put sector in use. Each athlete will receive 3 attempts. All fair attempts will be measured in metric units.
Discus	 There will be one discus sector in use. Each athlete will receive 3 attempts. All fair attempts will be measured in metric units.
Javelin	 There will be one javelin pit with a grass runway use. Each athlete will receive 3 attempts. All fair attempts will be measured in metric units.
Pole Vault	 There will be one composite pole vault pit in use. Starting Height: 8' 0" Attempts will be measured in metric units. Height progression will be opening height, then up by 15 centimeters.
Equipment	 Teams must provide their own throwing implements. Starting blocks will be provided by the host school. Teams cannot use their own. Please do not bring them.
Awards	 Top 5 finishers in each of the four events will receive awards. No team awards.
Results	 Live results will be available on www.mstcatiming.org. Final results will be posted on www.mstca.org, the official MSTCA web site.
Spikes	Only 1/8" or 1/4" Pyramid spikes are allowed on the track.
Emergency Contact	All coaches must have filled out an MSTCA Emergency Contact Form online (see MSTCA website) or pass in a hard copy at the meet before being allowed to retrieve your packet for your team.
