ENTRY INFORMATION

Participating teams must be from schools that are recognized members of their state associations affiliated with the National Federation of High Schools. (NFHS).

All schools that plan to attend the Boston Holiday Challenge, Team Pentathlon, Individual pentathlon, Holiday Qualifier must send the event manager an email declaring the intent to participate. This is a non-binding declaration, used to inform the NFHS of potential participants. This is for the purpose of obtaining a sanction for the meet.

TEAM & INDIVIDUAL PENTATHLON

Friday, December 27 Team Pentathlon Start Time 9:30am MUST by Check in at 9am

The Team Pentathlon is an event where a school team must be made up of five athletes, each athlete participating in only one event. Basically, you select your best athlete in each event and enter the five as a team. A school may enter only one boys' team and one girls' team. You should also have one or more alternates available. 'B' teams allowed if space permits and with permission of the meet director.

EVENTS

55 METER HURDLES - HIGH JUMP - SHOT PUT - LONG JUMP - 800 METERS (WOMEN) / 1,000 METERS (MEN)

The order of events will be as follows:

The 55 meter hurdles, then High Jump, shot put, and long jump. If necessary there will be several H.J. pits, two S.P. areas, and two L.J. pits is use. The H.J./L.J./S.P. will be conducted at the same time. At the conclusion of the three field events the heats for the 800 (women) or 1,000 (men) will be set up based on point totals.

Events for Individual & Team Pentathlon 55 M HH, SP, HJ, LJ, 800[Girls]/1000 Meters[Boys]

AWARDS:

Points will be awarded for performances in each event, and the boys' and girls' school scoring the highest number of points will be declared Team Pentathlon Champion.

Top 3 in both Boys & Girls Individual Pentathlon will receive awards.

Team plaques will be awarded to the first five teams in the competition based on total points. The top three teams will receive T-shirts.

FEE:

The cost of entering is \$40.00 per team. <u>Separate fees for boys and girls teams</u>, as well as, A and B teams.

The cost of entering is \$40 per individual in the pentathlon

If you enter a team your school is responsible for payment even if your team does not compete.

High Jump: Will be contested on the infield, boys in center, girls under scoreboard.

Meet Management:

- 1 The schedule is tentative and the meet may run up to 30 minutes ahead of schedule.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the athlete to be ready for competition when the event is called by the clerks.

Competitor Numbers:

- 1 Must be worn on the front of the uniform INCLUDING RELAYS.
- 2 Athletes must adhere to the NFHS rules regarding uniforms including relays.

<u>Batons</u> will be provided by meet management.

Clerking

- 1 Will be done in the gymnasium.
- 2 Clerks will have an initial check-in, then hand out heat and lane assignments and distribute hip numbers.
- 3 Athletes will be escorted to the track by a clerk.

<u>Spikes</u>

Only 1/4" pyramid spikes are allowed, use of any other spikes will result in disqualification.

Warm-ups

- 1 Restricted to the gymnasium area and outside, weather permitting.
- 2 There will be no warming up on the track once the meet begins.

Starting Heights

- 1 High Jump: Girls 4'07"; Boys 5'08"
- 2 Height progression will increase by 2 inches.

Shot Put & Long Jump

- 1 Top 8 will advance to the Finals.
- 2 Best flights last.

4 x 200 Meter Relay

3-turn stagger, sections based on seed time, fastest section last.

4 x 800 Meter Relay

2-turn stagger, sections based on seed time, fastest section last.

600 M, 1000M, Mile, 2 Mile

2-turn stagger, sections based on seed time, fastest section last
