Entry Information

1. **To determine which MSTCA division (LARGE OR SMALL) your team will compete in, please find your school on the MSTCA list starting on page 4. If your school's enrollment is 1,100 students or more, your school will compete in the large school division for this meet. If enrollment is less than 1,100 students, your school will compete in the small school division. The enrollment figures have been taken from information on the MIAA website.**
2. M.I.A.A. and National Federation rules and guidelines will be in effect for this meet. UNIFORM RULE WILL BE ENFORCED. The one-false-start rule will be in effect.
3. This meet is **only** for athletes enrolled as **FRESHMEN** or **SOPHOMORES** in high school. **Do not enter any 7th or 8th graders. An athlete may compete in one running, one field, and one relay event.**
4. A school may enter **TWO ATHLETES** per event as long as they have met the qualifying standards listed above. You may enter a third athlete in an event if that athlete has achieved the qualifying standard for that event. **You are expected to enter your two best athletes. Do not enter two athletes and then ask to enter a third athlete who is better than the other two.** You must contact the Meet Director **no later than Tuesday, January 3 midnight** to obtain permission to enter the third person, no exceptions! **The athletes must have ACHIEVED these marks in previous competition, these are not "anticipated" marks. This is a CHAMPIONSHIP meet, not a DEVELOPMENTAL meet. Athletes entered without seed times (NT) or distances (ND) will not be accepted.**
5. **AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to the top eight (8) placers in each event, including the relays. There is no team award. There will be a trackside award ceremony as soon as the results are available. Make sure your athletes are present for their event ceremony.**
6. **SPIKES: The Reggie Lewis Track is a fast 200-meter Mondo Super-X banked surface. Only 1/4" or 1/8" PYRAMID spikes allowed on the track. Anyone using longer spikes or other style spikes will be disqualified immediately for the remainder of the meet. THE REGGIE LEWIS CENTER HAS A WOODEN FLOOR IN THE GYM, PLEASE, NO SPIKES IN THE GYM!**
7. **ENTRY DEADLINE: ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETED BY TUESDAY, JANUARY 3, 2017, MIDNIGHT.**

- 8. You **MUST** enter on-line using www.DirectAthletics.com. Please read and follow the instructions for the entry process for the meet on the MSTCA web site.
- 9. No switching of events will be allowed. Athletes must compete in the events in which they are entered. No school will be allowed to compete in the division that does not match their enrollment. Boys and Girls compete in the same division. No exceptions.
- 10. **ENTRY FEES:** \$75.00 per school team (separate boys' and girls' fees) \$150 maximum per school, or \$5.00 per athlete, per event and \$15.00 per relay team, whichever is less. **If you enter athletes into this meet, your school is responsible for payment of the entry fees, even if they do not compete.**

If your school uses the Single Payment option, you complete the entry process, come to the meet and pick up your packet. Information and instructions for the Single Payment Option are on the MSTCA web site, www.mstca.org.

If payment is not received before meet day, you may bring payment to the meet, but you must notify the meet director of your plan to do so. If payment is not received, your team will not be allowed to participate.

- 11. **LATE ENTRIES AND FEES:** Late entries are strongly discouraged; however there is a late fee policy for MSTCA meets. If you miss the Tuesday (1/3/17) deadline, and still want your team to compete, **you must contact the meet director by Wednesday, 1/4, no later than 7 p.m.** He is the only one to deal with this request. You will not be able to access Direct Athletics. The late fee will be \$100 **per person or relay**. **No entries will be accepted after Wednesday 1/4 at 7:00 p.m.** Schools that enter late entrants must bring to the meet a check or Purchase Order for the entry fees plus the late fees, to give to the meet director, or they will not be allowed to compete.
- 12. **INCLEMENT WEATHER.** Any decision to cancel the meet because of inclement weather will be made by 6:00 a.m. on meet day. There is no make-up date. If in doubt, you may call one of the following to check:

After Completion of High Jump:

Hurdles Trials: serpentine seeding based on entry time, fast to slow, **fastest 16 advance to a two-section final.**

Dash Trials: serpentine seeding based on entry time, fast to slow, **fastest 16 advance to a two-section final.**

Hurdle Finals: Girls before Boys

Dash Finals: Boys before Girls

Please do NOT enter athletes who have not achieved the qualifying standards in previous competition; seed marks cannot be “anticipated” or “estimated” marks.

Long Jump: Each athlete will have **two attempts**; the best nine jumpers will advance to a final for two more attempts. All first **legal** jumps will be measured. Then, only jumps of **12'** and over (girls) and **15'** and over (boys) will be measured.

Shot Put: Each athlete will have **three attempts**; the best nine throwers will advance to a final. All first **legal** throws will be measured. Then, only throws of **21'** and over for the girls and **30'** and over for the boys will be measured. The meet will supply shots - leave your implements at home, they will not be allowed, even in practice.

Spikes: Only 1/4" or 1/8" pyramid spikes or flats are allowed on the track. Spikes may only be worn on the track, and no other place in the building. Use of needle spikes or longer spikes will be reason for disqualification for the rest of the meet.

Check-In: Please make sure your athletes are properly informed of the check-in procedure in the gym. **All athletes must check in for their event when called. If they don't check in when called, they will not be allowed to compete. No exceptions.**
